Title V FY 2022 Application



Background

- Title V is the federal block grant program that provides formula funding to states for maternal and child health services
- Annual Report and Application assessing progress in achieving identified performance measures
- States are required to identify at a minimum of 5/15 National Performance Measures during a Needs Assessment
- States may identify State Performance Measures to align with state priorities
